I, the undersigned, find that the defendant named above has been arrested without a warrant and the defendant's detention is justified because there is probable cause to believe that on or about the date of offense shown and in the county named above the defendant named above unlawfully and willfully did GO ARMED TO THE TERROR OF THE PUBLIC BY REMOVING HOMEMADE EXPLOSIVES FROM HIS VEHICLE A GREY KIA FORTE. AFTER THE EXPLOSIVE DEVICES WERE REMOVED WITNESSES WHO WERE STANDING NEARBY BECAME CONCERNED AND SCARED AND CALLED 911 TO REPORT AN INDIVIDUAL LATER IDENTIFIED AS THE DEFENDANT AS HAVING A BOMB. OFFICERS LOCATED THE DEVICES WHICH WERE CONFIRMED TO BE HOMEMADE EXPLOSIVES.
